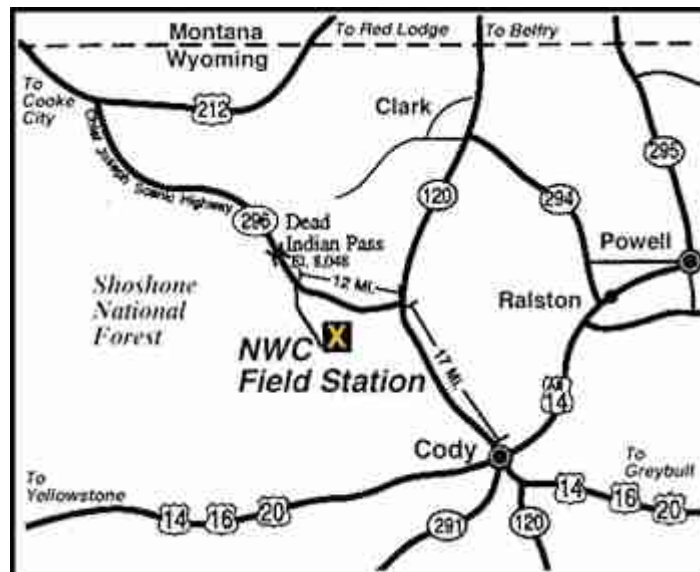
A maximum of 8 students per instructor for each class will be accepted. Once the class is filled it will be closed to additional registrations. Check the website and newsletter for class closure.

## Location

Northwest College's A. L. Mickelson Field Station is located 30 miles NW of Cody, WY. on Dead Indian Hill in the Absaroka Mountain Range, just off the Chief Joseph Scenic Highway. It is only a few miles from the spectacular Sunlight Basin, 55 miles from the northeast gate of Yellowstone National Park, 50 miles from the Northwest College campus, and 30 miles from Cody, Wyoming.
