#### Minutes of a Quarterly Meeting of the Board of Directors

December 7, 2017 certified

The fourth quarter meeting of the Board of Directors of the National Search Dog Alliance was held by conference call on Thursday, December 7, 2017. President Snelling called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. EST.

Members of the Board were asked if there were any corrections to the minutes from the November 2, 2017, meeting that they received via e-mail prior to the meeting. President Snelling called attention to the misspelling of the word envelope. The correction was made and the minutes were approved as corrected.

## Officer's Reports

President's Report, Norma Snelling

President Snelling reported that there has been a glitch in printing the new membership cards. The first printing will be the October/November renewals.

#### Vice-President's Report, Susan Fleming

Vice-President Fleming stated that the gift matching by the Bill Gates Foundation ended on November 28, 2017. As NSDA had not met their \$200 goal by that date, there were no matching monies. NSDA's Giving Tuesday total was \$365.

#### Secretary's Report, Sue Wolff

Secretary Wolff reported that 68 NSDA e-cards went out December 5, 2017, to Founding members, Life members, members of the Board of Directors, Program Managers, and Evaluators. Of those, three were undeliverable and all are with earthlink.net: Marcia Koenig, Lenore Ceithami & Lance Clarkson. As of 11 a.m. ET today, 28 have been opened. Two cards had to be snail mailed: Valerie Mokides & Kyle Warren because neither has an e-mail on file with NSDA. A request for one was included in their cards.

## Treasurer's Report, Heather Proper-Van Valkenberg

The Treasurer reported that the Expense and Income Report, the Expense and Income Detail and the Financial Position Report had been sent out.

#### **Program Reports**

## Education Program, Roy Pescador

Director Pescador stated that he has completed two videos: Area and Trailing. He was requested to send them to all the Board members which he promised to do.

## Evaluation Program, Nancy Acebo

As Program Director Acebo was unable to attend, she submitted a report regarding Evaluator additions and changes.

## Testing Administrator/Resource Manager, Sherry Scruggs

Director Scruggs stated that ninety-nine (99) certification tests have been conducted as of November 21, 2017. She stated that Evaluators are sending their forms to the wrong people even though the correct person is on that form. President Snelling directed Director Scruggs to contact Evaluation Program Chair Acebo after the holidays to develop a message for all Evaluators as a refresher of who the forms go to and to be sure that the process is stressed in the Evaluator Workshop adding slides if necessary.

#### Newsletter, Norma Snelling

Co-Editor Snelling reported that the subscriptions have been fluctuating but are at 1,309 as of this date.

## Testing Program, Karen Nesbitt

Program Director Nesbitt reported that seven (7) new tests have been scheduled (six [6] closed tests and one [1] open test). The open test is in California and is an Avalanche test. The tests go from November 19, 2017 up until April 2018. There might be some overlap since she last reported the tests. All are on the NSDA website.

#### Website Liaison, Laurie Strite

Unable to attend. She reported fifteen (15) completed change requests & no known problems. She also sent statistics on visitors, visits and hits.

#### **Unfinished Business**

Bylaws: Article VI, Board of Directors, Section 1B; Norma Snelling
As long as the NSDA Board of Directors consists of seven (7)
members, up to two (2) of those members may be non-US citizens.
This may be reviewed by the Board on a case-by-case basis and the Board reserves the right to reject any applicant.

Thirty days in advance of this meeting, an e-mail went out to all NSDA members regarding the above change to the NSDA Bylaws. Secretary Wolff reported two favorable comments were received regarding the Bylaws Board of Directors membership change:

As there were no negative reactions, the change was approved.

Presentation Board, Sherry Scruggs

Director Scruggs said that she has the presentation board but still needs the table cover with the NSDA logo on it. She asked that handlers still send act ion pictures and Editor Snelling said the request would go in the December issue.

Director Jen Skeldon said that she has been working on obtaining K-9 ID cards for NSDA certified dogs and that all she has found so far is companies that only print in bulk. She is still looking for a printer who will do individual cards to order.

Director Skeldon reported that she has checked with companies for pro-deals for our members and the companies want all membership information i.e. address, e-mail, etc. The Executive Committee will discuss this situation at their meeting on December 21, 2017, and will include Director Skeldon in that meeting.

#### **New Business**

Policies & Procedures: Section 5.3, Elections, Norma Snelling

Secretary Wolff made a motion, seconded by Director Scruggs, to remove the voting regions. After a short discussion about this bringing the Policies and Procedures in line with the Bylaws, the motion was passed unanimously.

2018 Proposed Budget, Heather Proper-Van Valkenberg

Treasurer Proper-Van Valkenberg stated that some figures need to be updated and she will e-mail the proposed budget when it is completed.

There being no further business, Secretary Wolff made a motion, seconded by Vice-President Fleming, to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 7:51 p.m. EST.


